

SmartMouse Tool User Manual

SmartMouse is a multifunction setup tool for gaming mouse, which has user friendly operation interface and powerful function setting. It is supported by Win XP/Vista/7/8 system. Operation interface is shown as below:



Schematic diagram shows “keys setting” , “CPI and other settings” function option of three function pages and a standard mouse button. Function operation is described below.

Mouse identification:

After entering the interface, if no applicable mouse is identified, selection button and function options on the page will be gray and non-operable. When mouse is identified, all options will turn to light yellow, as shown below:



1. Key setting:

Left click pull-down menu according to key number. Options with arrow means more options are available. Move mouse cursor, all options contained will be shown as below:




Note: combination key refers to combination with Ctrl /Alt /Win /Shift key and any 1 or 2 keys on keyboard. Ctrl, Alt, Win and Shift will be selected by check, while other random key will be selected by pressing keyboard (data collection).



2. CPI setting and other settings

Notification light:




LED mode:

LED mode has two LED options



CPI


CPI gear setting:



CPI gear has three options: all gears (gear 1, gear 2, gear 3 and gear4) are selected by check. Current CPI is optional by change pull-down menu according to total gear number. CPI gear value is determined by dragging the bar.


Report rate


Refresh rate of mouse, three options: 125HZ, 500HZ, 1000HZ.




3. File recovery

File recovery has three operation options:

Export, means saving current set value on file, when move mouse to  icon, it prompts “save as”, after click, save path window appears to user-define path, standard name of export document is SmartMouse(EU).ini.

Import, means loading one group of setting by user-defined path to set up mouse, when move mouse to  icon, it prompts “open from”, after click, load path window appears for path selection, title of the setup document must be SmartMouse (EU), otherwise it won't be identified.

Reset to factory defaults. Press  to reset to factory default.
